Interested participants may submit the abstract of not more than 250 words, Microsoft Word doc format, arial, font size - 12, with title of the paper, name of the researcher/s or authors and the name of the institution. Abstracts can be emailed to buemd@bicol-u.edu.ph on or before June 30, 2018. Authors will be given feedback within one week of submission.
